

TeenSkills



The “**TeenSkills**” program, which began three years ago with 4 schools, now aims to empower students from 20 Junior High Schools, mainly those in their final year, in remote and hard-to-reach areas, from Rizomata in Imathia to the island of Psara, where young people often have limited access to information about their future.

Through live group sessions with mentors from a wide range of professional backgrounds, students are introduced to different occupations and connect with the modern labour market and its challenges. They then work in teams to develop essential skills such as collaboration, critical thinking, creativity, and problem-solving, turning their ideas into projects that address a real issue within their local community.

More specifically, the program enables students to:

- **explore** the options available to them after finishing school and develop a broader understanding of the opportunities each one offers,
- **receive guidance** on future choices through interaction with accomplished professionals,
- **build** key soft and digital skills,
- **reconsider** what their local community can offer them by discovering entrepreneurial and other career opportunities.

The program is implemented, for the 3rd consecutive time during the 2025-2026 school year, in strategic cooperation with **Piraeus** in the framework of the Bank's Corporate Responsibility programme “**EQUALL** - For a Society of Equal People”, under the “New Generation” pillar.
