Secondary school students, including schools that will operate as **Onassis Public Schools** from the 2025–26 school year, take part in live group sessions with Members of the Onassis Scholars' Association, who take on the role of mentors. More specifically, mentors from a wide range of fields help students explore career paths in research, culture, entrepreneurship, leadership, technology, the humanities as well as social sciences, and the natural sciences. At the same time, they inspire students by sharing their personal journey, academic and professional experiences, and the role the Onassis Foundation Scholars' Program has played in helping them achieve their goals.

Through their participation in the initiative, students aim to:

- explore the aforementioned fields and professions within today's labour market,
- draw inspiration from the mentors' journey and achievements,
- broaden their horizons by discovering new career pathways.
